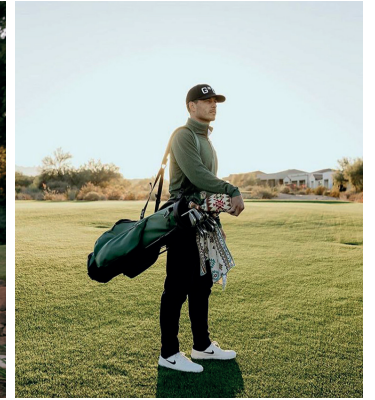

Centered around Sotogrande and Marbella, *the journey blends Ronda* wine culture and local rituals.



The Golf Experience

Sotogrande brings together three of Europe's most distinctive golfing experiences, each with its own character, rhythm and level of intensity. From the iconic stature of Real Club Valderrama to the timeless elegance of Real Club de Golf Sotogrande and the contemporary refinement of La Reserva Club Sotogrande, the journey unfolds with remarkable balance. More than a succession of rounds, it is an immersion into one of the most sophisticated golf destinations in Europe.

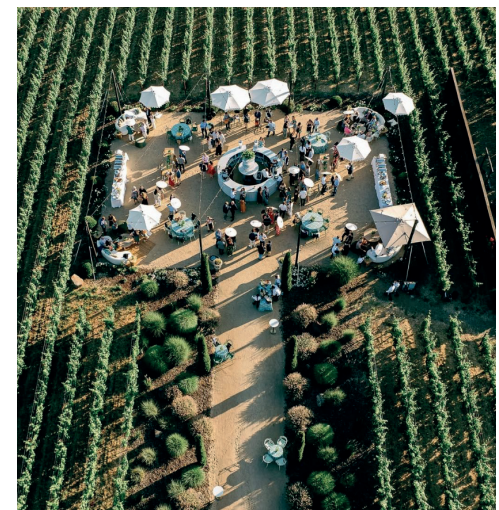


- **Real Club Valderrama (Sotogrande)** Valderrama is Spain's benchmark for championship golf: cork oaks, immaculate conditioning, and a routing that feels relentlessly precise. Shaped by Robert Trent Jones Sr., it's famous for tight driving corridors, exacting approaches, and greens that reward control more than power. Its reputation was sealed globally when it hosted the 1997 Ryder Cup—an event that still defines the club's aura today. For discerning golfers, this is the “must-play” round where every shot matters and the atmosphere feels unmistakably elite.
- **Real Club de Golf Sotogrande** Inaugurated in 1964, this was Robert Trent Jones Sr.'s first course in Europe—and it still reads like a masterclass in understated design. It's classic Sotogrande: pines and cork oaks, generous-looking lines that turn demanding once you start chasing perfect angles into the greens. The experience is quietly refined—strategic, timeless, and built for golfers who appreciate nuance over theatre. It's the ideal counterpoint to Valderrama: less severe, but every bit as “proper.”
- **La Reserva Club Sotogrande** La Reserva is the modern chapter of Sotogrande golf: spacious, beautifully presented, and designed for a premium day on and off the course. Opened in 2003 and designed by Cabell B. Robinson, it brings wider fairways, big greens, and bold shaping—plus genuine elevation and Mediterranean views. It's playable for mixed abilities, yet still asks for smart decisions, especially around water and pin positions. A polished, contemporary complement to the two great “old souls” next door.

For discerning travellers drawn to fine wines, gourmet cuisine and refined experiences, Andalusia unfolds as a destination of warmth, character and understated sophistication. Through curated culinary and wine encounters, this journey invites guests to discover one of southern Spain's most flavourful and captivating regions.

- **A Taste of Paradise**

Undoubtedly one of the finest wineries in the Ronda region, Cortijo Los Aguilares boasts an exceptional terroir. Guests surrender to a unique indulgence: a leisurely picnic with the winery's wines among the sun-drenched vines, set against a wild, breathtaking landscape. Every bite, every sip becomes a delicious moment suspended in time.

- **An Intimate Winery Escape in Ronda**

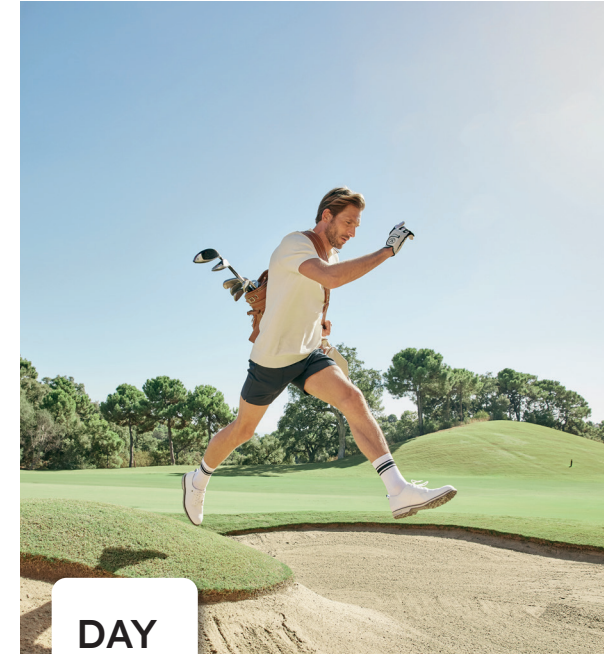
