unveil a limited *Bordeaux private edition*, where the art of French living meets the passion for golf and the finesse of Grand Cru wines. Nestled among Bordeaux's most prestigious vineyards and legendary golf courses, each experience is meticulously crafted for the finest connoisseurs. Here, elegance unfolds in private tastings at **classified châteaux**, rounds on iconic fairways, and nights in refined residences where luxury whispers. Every detail is designed to harmonize golf, gastronomy, and heritage, creating moments where time seems to stand still.



The Golf Experience

Bordeaux delivers luxury without noise: a world-class wine culture, a refined city, and landscapes that naturally set the pace. **This programme is built as a curated progression**, moving from architectural, strategic golf to timeless private-club tradition, then finishing with a distinctly Atlantic change of scenery. Four rounds, four atmospheres—one coherent journey shaped by taste, rhythm, and a strong sense of place.



• Cabot Bordeaux (Châteaux & Vignes)

A true stay-and-play base near Bordeaux with two 18-hole courses that complement each other perfectly. Châteaux (Bill Coore, 1987) was conceived as a **modern tribute to Tom Simpson**—fast-and-firm, strategic, and very architectural. Vignes (Rod Whitman, created two years later) is the tighter, sharper test, with narrower corridors and more demanding greens. Together, it's an ideal **two-round destination that feels premium without being overbuilt**.

• Golf du Grand Saint-Emilionnais

A **modern reference course set directly in Saint-Émilion** wine country. Designed by Tom Doak, it sits in a natural valley framed by mature trees and vineyards, with a routing that feels minimal, pure and effortless. The real signature is the green complexes: subtle and intelligent, rewarding precise approach play. For discerning players, it's one of the most memorable golf stops in the region.

• Golf Bordelais

A rare **“city club” with real heritage** : founded in 1900, private in spirit, and still one of France’s oldest clubs. The course is compact and classic, where placement matters more than power and every mistake is quietly punished by tighter lines and small targets. Perfect for clients who love traditional club atmospheres and want a timeless Bordeaux round without leaving the city.

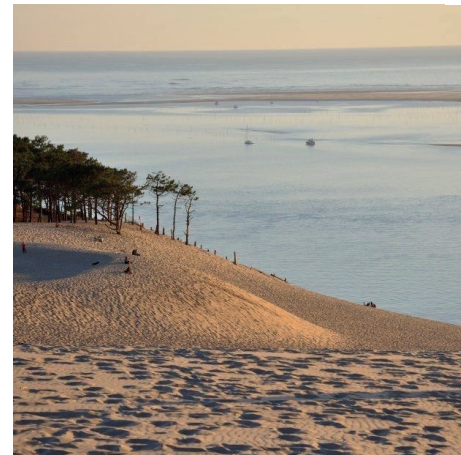
• Golf d’Arcachon (Golf International d’Arcachon)

An Atlantic coastal-forest classic near Arcachon Bay, minutes from the Dune du Pilat. Golf has existed here since 1895 (originally 9 holes), with the current 18-hole course opened in 1960, set among maritime pines and sandy soil for a very “seaside” feel. It’s an easy addition to a Bordeaux programme when you want fresh air, atmosphere, and a distinct coastal change of scenery.

The guests explore the essence of Bordeaux's terroir, where the Garonne and Dordogne rivers weave through a landscape of gravelly soils and gentle slopes, crafting wines of unparalleled elegance. This is the birthplace of legendary reds—structured, refined, and imbued with the soul of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot—as well as vibrant whites and luscious dessert wines from Sauternes. Each appellation, from the powerful Pauillac to the silky Saint-Émilion, tells a story of tradition, innovation, and the unique alchemy between earth and vine.



- **Timeless Elegance: A Private Rendez vous at Château Cos d'Estournel**

An exclusive appointment at **Château Cos d'Estournel**, one of the Médoc's most refined estates, where timeless elegance meets the soul of the vineyard. Your journey begins with a private walk through the vines, immersing you in the essence of this exceptional terroir. In the estate's magnificent tasting room, you will enjoy five wines—both red and white—each revealing the distinctive character of Cos d'Estournel;

- **The Art of Living in Arcachon Bay: Private Cruise & Seafood Indulgence**

The guests escape to **Arcachon Bay**, where the Atlantic's charm meets timeless elegance. They embark on a private wooden boat cruise, savoring fresh

oysters and crisp white wine in a secluded fisherman's hut. Afterward, they indulge in a seafood lunch by the water, followed by leisurely moments exploring the dune, lighthouse, or fishing villages.

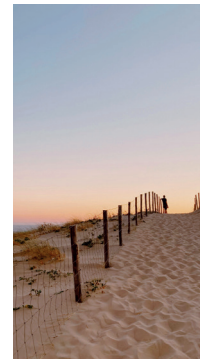
- **Exclusive Wine & Picnic Experience in Saint Emilion**

Escape into the art of Saint-Émilion's terroir with a tailor-made picnic among the vines, where the legendary Grand Cru Classé wines of **Château Troplong Mondot** meet the tranquility of its rolling estate. After a private tour of the biodynamic vineyards and cellars, guests discover the secrets of their velvety and expressive vintages, then retreat to a secluded grove atop a hill. There, a carefully prepared picnic basket, overflowing with artisanal charcuterie, seasonal delicacies, and homemade treats from Les Belles Perdrix, the estate's Michelin restaurant, awaits them in the shade of century-old trees.

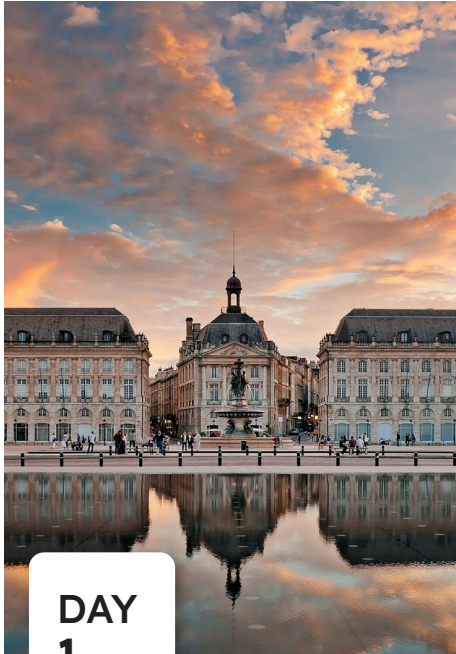

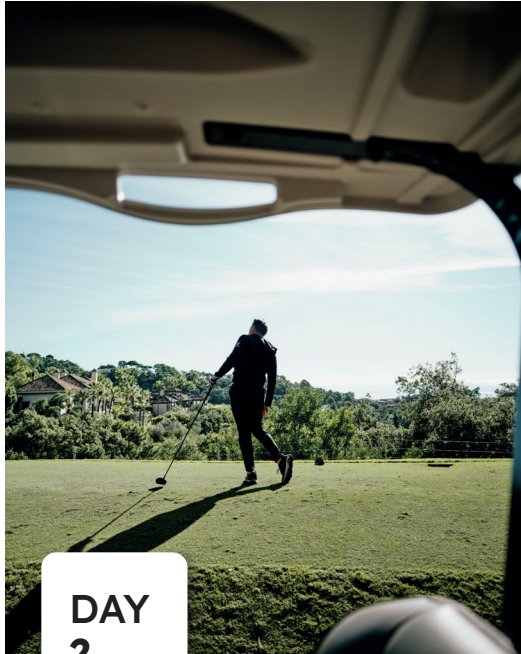

**DAY
1**

Welcome to bordeaux!

- Your private chauffeur meets you at Bordeaux airport or train station and drives you to your 5 stars hotel in the city.
- Check in and settle in.
- When you're ready, lovely local guide collects you at hotel and embarks you on a private tour of the city to discover how Bordeaux's history is intertwined with its wine! This walking tour includes some wine tasting of course.
- **Welcome dinner at Michelin or traditional restaurant, depending on your preferences.**
- Overnight in Bordeaux.



**DAY
2**

Golfing day : The Bordelais Golf

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to Golf Bordelais.
- Inaugurated in 1900, the Golf Bordelais is one of the five oldest golf courses in France. The land on which the course is located has been a bivouac for Napoleon's armies, and a hunting ground before a handful of enthusiasts decided to transform it into a 9-hole golf course. From the very first year, the Golf Bordelais organized matches with the Golf d'Arcachon, Dieppe, Biarritz and Bordeaux on a barren, treeless site whose fairways were mowed by a flock of sheep. In 1927, under pressure from the players, the real estate company decided to acquire the entire moor, including the Club House we know today. This acquisition was later used to design and lay out an 18-hole course that differed from the one we know today.
- Booking for Lunch at boutique restaurant Maison Pavlov for a relaxed gastro bistro lunch.
- Transfer back to hotel and rest of the afternoon at leisure.
- Dinner in Bordeaux with our recommendations.
- Overnight in Bordeaux.



**DAY
3**

Legendary Medoc

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Your driver will collect you at hotel after breakfast, you're exploring the mythical Medoc wine region today! During your day, you will discover 3 famous appellations: Margaux, Pauillac, and Saint-Estephe. You will enjoy a first appointment at wine **Chateau Kirwan in Margaux** area. Kirwan really is your fairytale chateau! After a tour of the property, you will be invited to a comparative tasting of the wine still in barrel and of the vintage of your choice. This is the perfect experience to grasp the complexity of ageing and winemaking. You will then make your way to **Chateau Pichon-Baron**, in the wine area of Pauillac. After a tour of the elegant property, which is a perfect blend of historic features and super modern architecture, and a visit of the underground cellar, you will enjoy a **seated wine pairing lunch in a private salon.**
- In the afternoon, your tour ends on a very high note with a private appointment at **Cos d'Estournel**, arguably one of the most beautiful property of Medoc. After a walk in the vineyards, you will taste 5 Cos wines, red and white, in the somptuous tasting room.
- Your chauffeur drives you back to your hotel at the end of the afternoon.
- Dinner in Bordeaux with our recommendations.
- Overnight in Bordeaux.





**DAY
4**

Golfing day : Cabot Bordeaux

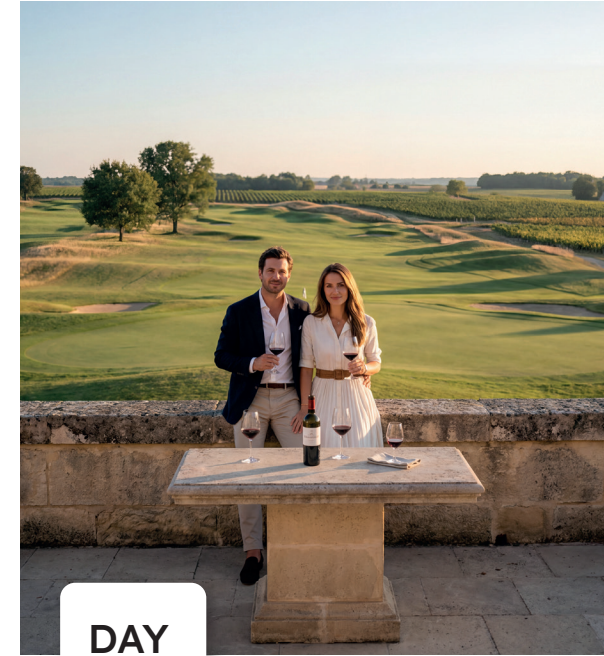
- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to Cabot Bordeaux golf course.
- Cabot Bordeaux offers 2 iconic 18-hole courses : the Chateaux course and the Vignes course. Châteaux course was designed by Bill Coore in 1987, as an homage to Tom Simpson's beautiful work. Rod Whitman, who helped Bill Coore build Châteaux in 1987, designed Vignes two years later with shorter holes, tighter fairways, and more severe greens than its counterpart.
- Booking for lunch at Golf's restaurant Le Club.
- In the afternoon, indulge in a relaxing treatment at the resort's spa. The spa features a heated indoor swimming pool, hammam, fitness rooms, massages and holistic treatments.
- Transfer back to hotel.
- Dinner in Bordeaux with our recommendations.
- Overnight in Bordeaux.



**DAY
5**

Emblematic wine estates

- Breakfast at hotel and check out as you will stay in Saint-Emilion for the next 3 nights. But before, you will enjoy 2 wine experiences at 2 emblematic wine estates.
- The first estate you will visit this morning is **Chateau Haut Brion**, one of the 1855 Premiers Grands crus classés, located in the Pessac-Léognan appellation. Clarence Dillon purchased this chateau in 1935 and his vision is now continued by the fourth generation of the family, represented by Prince Robert of Luxembourg, Chairman and CEO since 2008. You will enjoy a tasting of this legendary wine in a private salon.
- Lunch will be enjoyed in luxury resort Les Sources de Caudalie, in **La Table du Lavoir**, a gourmet bistro overlooking Chateau Smith Haut Lafite vineyards and the works of art that ornate them.



**DAY
6**

Golfing day: Golf du Grand Saint-Emilionnais

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to Golf du Grand Saint-Emilionnais.
- The Golf du Grand Saint-Emilionnais is located on an exceptional natural site, and offers a 18 holes course ranked in the French Top 3 and designed by Tom Doak, the world's best golf course architect. A site of striking natural beauty, close to the village of Saint Emilion, this exceptional course transports you into a valley bordered by centuries-old oaks, pines, heather, gorse and vines.
- Reservation for lunch at the golf restaurant and its superb panoramic terrace overlooking the golf course, for a relaxed lunch of authentic cuisine based on fresh local produce.
- Transfer back to hotel. Rest of the day at leisure, I recommend enjoying a glass of wine in front of the vineyards to end the day!
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight in Saint-Emilion.



DAY
7

Saint-Emilion hamlet & Vineyards

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to Chateau Troplong-Mondot. You will spend the morning discovering this beautiful wine chateau surrounded by its vineyards, farm, forest, an ode to nature and sustainability. You will roam through the vineyards aboard an old Land Rover and discover the property's hidden treasures and its most beautiful viewpoints. Understand the particularities of its 'terroir'. See the plough horses hard at work and the vat cellar in action. This is followed by a vertical tasting session of both Mondot and Troplong Mondot wines. But it does not stop here! The experience continues with a private wine picnic in a hidden spot overlooking on ocean of vines. Enjoy the moment!
- In the afternoon, you will meet a local guide to explore the hamlet and its underground monuments, including the monolithic church.
- Rest of the afternoon at leisure to get ready for tonight's Michelin dinner at Chef Aleno's La Table de Pavie.
- Food and wine pairing dinner at La Table de Pavie.
- Overnight in Saint-Emilion.



DAY
8

Arcachon bay

- Breakfast at hotel and check out.
- Private transfer to the Atlantic coast, to the Hamptons-like area called Arcachon bay, where you will stay for the last leg of your trip. Arcachon bay is famous for the Dune du Pilat, Europe's highest sand dune, the dune du Pilat, the bayside city of Arcachon, its fishermen villages and Cap Ferret lighthouse.
- Arrive in Arcachon, where your captain awaits you for a **private excursion on the bay in a traditional** wooden boat. The ideal way to embrace the unique landscape and wildlife. You will stop in one of the fishermen's hut to **taste some oysters with a glass of white wine**.
- At the end of your cruise, you will enjoy a **seafood lunch** at one of the restaurants lining the bay on the Ferret side.
- After lunch, you have some free time to enjoy the village, the lighthouse, the bay... Take your time!
- In the afternoon, check in your beautiful **hotel Co(o)rniche**, an architecture jewel designed by French star designer Philippe Starck, overlooking the bay.
- Rest of the day at leisure and dinner at your hotel.
- Overnight in Arcachon.



DAY
9

Golfing day: Golf d'Arcachon

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to Golf d'Arcachon course.
- Located on the Atlantic coast on the shores of the Bay of Arcachon, and adjacent to the highest dune in Europe, the Arcachon International Golf Club is an 18-hole course. Created as a 9-hole course by a private golfer in 1895 (the Exshaw family, including William), it was subsequently opened as an 18-hole course in 1960, managed by a non-profit Association Sportive and open to the public wishing to become Members. It was designed by Cecil Blandford, renowned architect of numerous golf courses, notably in Europe, and built under the direction of Pierre Hirigoyen. It enjoys an exceptional location in a wooded setting of maritime pines, oaks and arbutus trees, not forgetting the magnificent mimosas.
- Booking for lunch at the Golf's restaurant "Le Club des Toqués".
- Rest of the afternoon at leisure.
- Goodbye dinner at La Co(o)rniche.
- Overnight in Arcachon.



DAY
10

- Breakfast at hotel and check out.
- Private transfer to Bordeaux airport or train station.



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
