# The Golf Experience

Over eight days, this journey through Burgundy combines refined golf, world-class wines, and the understated elegance of one of France's most iconic regions. Between beautifully maintained courses, vineyard landscapes, historic estates, and exceptional gastronomy, every moment is designed to balance play, pleasure, and discovery. A sophisticated escape for golfers who seek more than a round: a true art of living.



- **Country Club de Norges Dijon** (Grands Crus)

Just outside Dijon, this is a beautifully kept forest course that feels quintessentially Burgundy—quiet, green, and wonderfully “proper.” Originally created in 1971 by architect Mickaël Fenn, it threads through woodland with a classic parkland rhythm and a strong emphasis on placement. The holes are varied without being brutal, making it a great “confidence round” that still asks you to think. An ideal base-course near the city: refined, consistent, and very playable.

- **Golf du Château de Chailly** (Rubillon)

A chateau setting, a calm countryside backdrop, and an 18-hole layout that's more strategic than showy. Opened in 1990 and designed by Thierry Sprecher and Géry Watine, it rewards angles and disciplined approach play—greens are well-protected and the course asks for smart positioning. The signature feeling is the contrast: serious golf, then an immediate “estate” atmosphere the moment you step off 18. Perfect for golfers who like elegance, not theatre.

- **Golf de Beaune Levernois**

A classic Burgundy vineyard setting, built for an enjoyable round with enough bite to keep good players interested. Open since 1989, it's notably flat and walkable, with a parkland feel shaped by mature trees, nine lakes, and plenty of clean, white-sand bunkering. The best part is the pace and scenery—golf that flows, then Beaune minutes away for wine and a long lunch. A great “group-friendly” course that still feels polished.

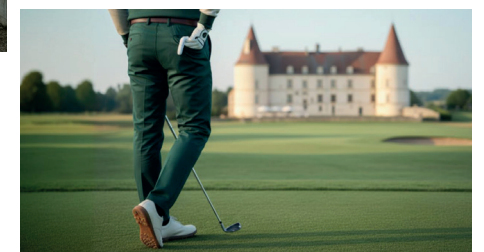
- **Golf du Roncemay** (Domaine de Roncemay)

A secluded Burgundy escape: woodland, water, and a routing that feels like it belongs to the landscape rather than imposed on it. Established in 1989 by Jean Garaïalde with designer Jeremy Pern, it mixes forest-lined holes with open sections, ponds, and demanding targets that reward calm decision-making. It's the kind of course where you finish the round feeling you could play it again immediately—same lines, different choices. Ideal for golfers who value serenity, nature, and a proper test without fuss.

The guests discover Albert Bichot, Burgundy's storied family wine house since 1831, and its deep ties to the legendary Hospices de Beaune auction, where it has been the top buyer

for over 20 years. They explore the historic headquarters and uncover the secrets of the 1443-founded charity auction, a cornerstone of Burgundy's heritage. A private tasting of rare wines—from Albert Bichot's estates and the Hospices—awaits, served from bottle or cask in Beaune's aging cellars. The experience includes a gourmet lunch in the family's Saint Nicolas house, blending tradition and elegance. An unforgettable immersion into Burgundy's wine legacy and timeless hospitality.

- Private transfer to Country Club de Norges Dijon.
- The 18-hole "Grand Crus" course offers a combination of technical, short holes on the front nine and longer holes with large greens on the back nine. Renowned for its high standard of maintenance, the 18-hole course is complemented by a 6-hole training course, a driving range, a putting green, an approach green and indoor facilities.
- Booking for Lunch at **Le Bistrot de Norges** for a relaxed bistro lunch.
- Transfer back to hotel and rest of the afternoon at leisure.

## A day with Albert Bichot

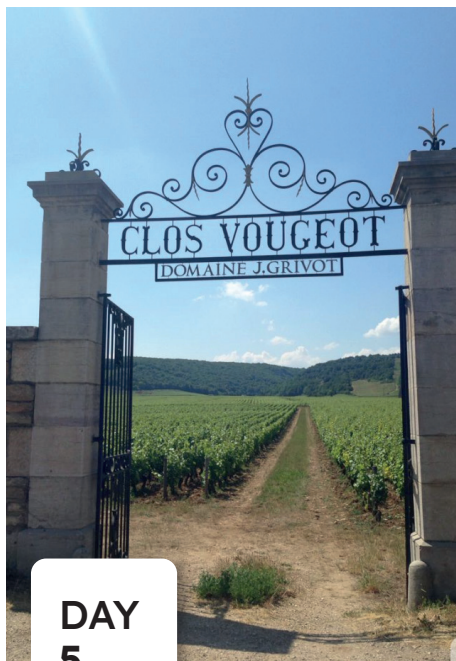
- Breakfast at hotel.
- The day is dedicated to Burgundy wines and those from the Hospices de Beaune at Albert Bichot, a prestigious family-owned winery and the leading buyer for the past 20 years at this famous auction, which is unique in the world. You will discover the exceptional history of this winegrowers' hospital founded in 1443, its estate and wines, as well as a behind-the-scenes look at this charity auction, which is unique in the world.
- You will be welcomed in Beaune at the headquarters of Maison Albert Bichot. After visiting the Colbert winery, you will taste several wines from the barrel and in bottles **in the cellar dedicated to aging Hospices wines.** Then you will visit one of the **Maison's estates** (Nuits Saint Georges or Pommard) for a tour and tasting.
- Lunch will take place at the **Saint-Nicolas "family home"** in Beaune
- In the afternoon, you will visit the **Hospices de Beaune, including the wine cellar.**
- Your chauffeur drives you back to your hotel at the end of the afternoon cellar.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight in Burgundy



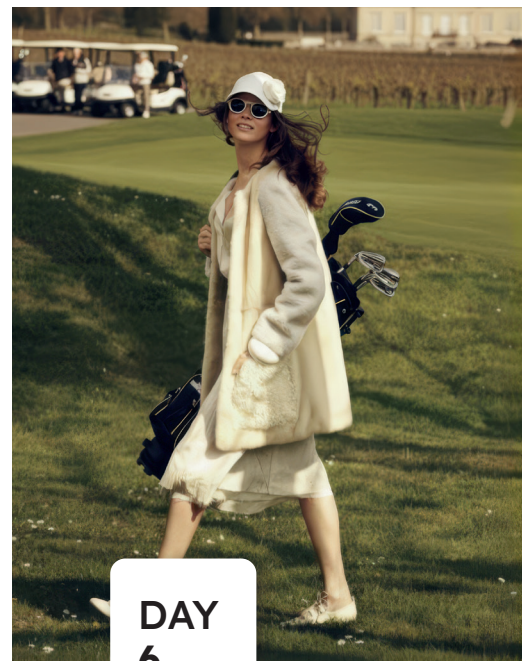

## Golfing day : Golf du Château de Chailly

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to the Golf.
- The Golf Hotel Château de Chailly is an 18-hole course designed by Thierry Sprecher and Géry Watine in 1990. Its course, Rubillon, is a par 72 measuring 6,036 meters. Hole No. 11 is the signature hole of the course, with the 16th-century castle in the background.
- Booking for lunch at Golf's restaurant La Table des Producteurs.
- Rest of the day at leisure.
- I recommend enjoying a glass of wine in front of the vineyards to end the day!
- Transfer back to hotel.
- Dinner with our recommendations.

## Legendary Côte de Nuits

- Breakfast at hotel.
- This day is dedicated to **the legendary Côte de Nuits**, home of the most sought-after Pinot Noirs, definitely a highlight! Côte de Nuits is this land stretching from Beaune in the south and Dijon up north and where the most emblematic Burgundian names can be found : Vosne-Romanée, Nuits-Saint-Georges, Gevrey-Chambertin, Chambolle-Musigny...
- In the morning, you will be welcomed at Family estate **Drouhin-Laroze** for a private tasting. Christine Drouhin will welcome you herself. Her wines are splendid.
- Arrive at **Chateau du Clos de Vougeot**, Burgundy's most famous landmark, a former wine chateau (not producing wine anymore), standing in a sea of vines, the seat of the order of the Tastevin brotherhood.
- Enjoy a wine lunch at the new restaurant called **La Table de Léonce** inside the chateau.
- In the afternoon, your guide will show you around : the walled clos, the nice viewpoints, the famous **Domaine de la Romanée-Conti** (from the outside) and its mythical plot « La Tâche ».

- You will enjoy one last VIP appointment at **Domaine Boisset** in **Nuits Saint-Georges**, the wines are complex and elegant. Boisset's Ursulines, located in a former covent, is a very special place.

## Golfing day: Golf de Beaune Levernois

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to **Golf de Beaune Levernois**
- Measuring 6,063 meters, the 18-hole course offers a long and technical layout, accessible to all skill levels with its forward tees. Its flat layout is nonetheless very varied. Its remarkable trees and nine ponds allow players to immerse themselves in a green and peaceful environment.
- After your course, you will have lunch at the **Au fil de l'eau** bistro, located next to the golf course.
- Transfer back to hotel. Afternoon at leisure
- In the early evening, your private driver will pick you up and take you to Gilly lès Citeaux for **Burgundian Food and wine private dinner**. Charlotte, a food and wine lecturer, who's also a journalist and a guide, and Joseph, a wine maker and merchant have teamed up to offer a special supper-club-type of experience : a private dinner focusing on Burgundy's forgotten traditional recipes, paired with carefully selected wines, held in a private venue in the heart of the village of Gilly-lès-Citeaux. This is definitely a special experience.
- Transfert back to hotel
- Overnight in Burgundy

## Chablis

- Breakfast at hotel and check out.
- Private transfer to **Chablis**, famous for its crisp white wines. This is also a great opportunity to discover the Northern Burgundian countryside and its cute villages.
- In the morning, stop in **Noyers** or **Flavigny-sur-Ozerain** (where the famous movie « Chocolat » was shot) for a nice stroll in the village.
- Late morning, arrive in **Chablis** where you will enjoy a VIP wine experience at one of our favorite estate there, **Maison Régnard**, which produces many 1er and grands crus.
- Lunch in nearby gastro-bistro **Au Fil du Zinc** restaurant.
- In the afternoon, enjoy a guided visit of **Vezelay, the village and its Basilica**.
- At the end of the afternoon, you will arrive at your hotel for the next two nights.
- Our recommendations: **La Cote Saint Jacques** or **Le Chateau de Vault de Lugny**
- Dinner at your hotel
- Overnight in Burgundy

## Golfing day: Golf du Roncemay

- Breakfast at hotel
- Private transfer to Golf du Roncemay
- Created in 1989 by Jean Garaïalde and Jeremy Pern, its 6,219-meter course winds through a forest of oak, beech, and birch trees that are hundreds of years old, opening onto a vast plateau shaped and colored in the style of Scottish links. The 5th hole with its lake, is a legendary hole on the course that combines performance and pleasure.
- Lunch at **the golf's bistro**
- Rest of the afternoon at leisure.
- Overnight in Burgundy
