# The Golf Experience



- **Domaine de Terre Blanche** (Tourettes, Provence)

A true five-star golf retreat, home to two 18-hole championship courses designed by Dave Thomas: **Le Château** and **Le Riou**. Opened in March 2004, Le Château is the signature test—water, ravines, fast greens and immaculate conditioning: pure “precision golf.” Le Riou is the more playful counterpart, still strategic, with constant Provençal panoramas and a superb sense of flow. Terre Blanche is also a serious training base, featuring a state-of-the-art **performance centre with European Tour Performance Institute status**.

- **Vidauban Golf Club** (formerly Le Prince de Provence)

**A legend in French golf:** ultra-private, set deep in the Plaine des Maures nature park, where the landscape feels untouched. It carries the Robert Trent Jones legacy—conceived on his own estate and routed through garrigue, umbrella pines, cork oaks and rocky outcrops. The course is demanding without being theatrical: it rewards restraint, angles and shot discipline rather than brute force. **Famously exclusive**, it has also been carefully upgraded in recent years in collaboration with the RTJ II team.

- **Old Course Golf Cannes-Mandelieu**

**A Côte d’Azur classic with real tournament DNA**, tucked into a natural valley just minutes from Cannes. Originally conceived in the 1920s with Harry Colt, it was later remodelled in the 1970s by Peter Alliss and Dave Thomas, and relaunched in 1978. The club then hosted the Cannes-Mougins Open (1979-1994)—European Tour from 1984—cementing its competitive edge. Further updated in 2015, it remains a refined, mature layout: elegant, technical, and quietly exacting.

The French Riviera programme brings together three complementary golf signatures, from the Provençal hinterland to the Côte d’Azur. From the five-star precision of Terre Blanche, to the wild, ultra-private exclusivity of Vidauban, and the tournament pedigree of Cannes-Mougins, the itinerary builds in intensity with real clarity. Three courses, three atmospheres—one shared thread: demanding, discreet, precision golf in the South of France’s most compelling settings.



# Wine Experiences & Unforgettable Moments

The French Riviera reveals itself as a sun-drenched playground dedicated to refined experiences, designed for the most discerning travellers. Its sun-drenched vineyards producing iconic rosé wines, its rich cultural heritage, picturesque villages, and glamorous seaside towns embody the very essence of French refinement. - **An Exclusive Rosé Masterpiece Experience**

A private tasting at Château d'Esclans, home to iconic cuvées like **Whispering Angel** and the ultra-premium **Garrus**, is an invitation into the refined world of Provence's most celebrated rosés. Set amidst sunlit vineyards, guests discover the craftsmanship and elegance behind each vintage.

- **Sacred Vines & Sea**

Embark on a private cruise to the serene island of Saint-Honorat, home to a monastic community since 410 AD. Nestled in this timeless setting, the eight-hectare vineyard is lovingly cultivated by the monks of the **Abbey of Lérins**.

Their dedication and savoir-faire give rise to wines of international renown, crafted in harmony with nature and tradition. An exclusive rosé tasting here becomes a rare and soulful experience, where heritage, spirituality, and Mediterranean elegance meet.

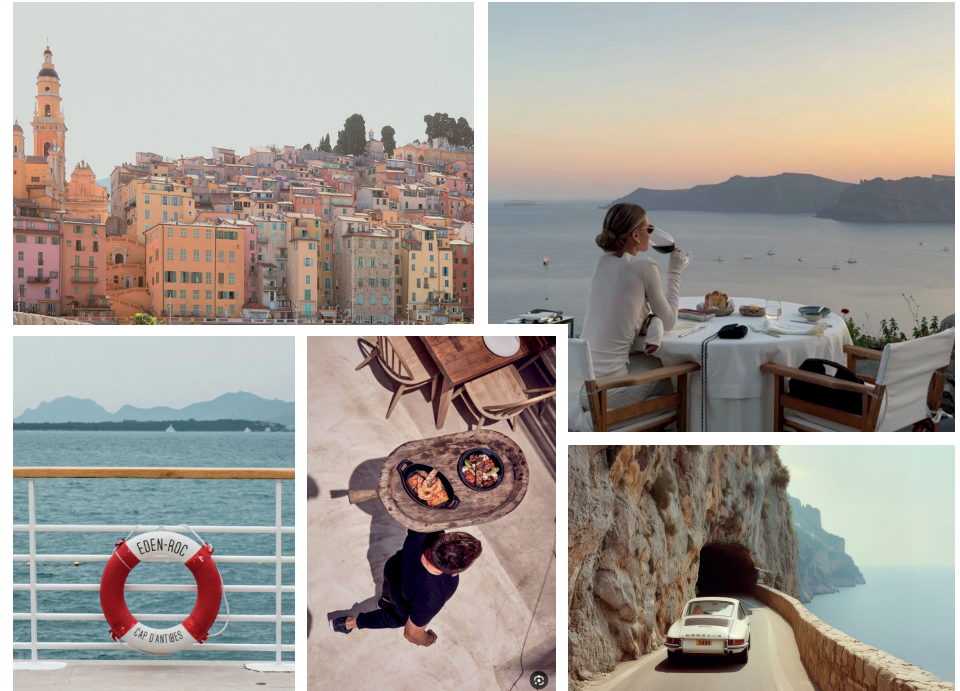
- **Artistic trail**

1**

## Welcome to the French Riviera!

- Your private chauffeur meets you at Nice airport and drives you to your 5 stars hotel.
- For the first leg of your trip, you can choose to stay in the city of Nice, or in other famous towns of the French Riviera such as Saint-Jean Cap Ferrat, Eze or Beaulieu-sur-mer.
- **Welcome dinner at Michelin or traditional restaurant, depending on your preferences.**
- Overnight in Nice area.

## Beach Fun and Monaco

- Breakfast at hotel.
- In the morning, we will organize the rental of a private boat, with your own captain, for half a day of sailing along the Mediterranean Coast. We can organize a picnic onboard, and some wine or Champagne of course!
- **In the afternoon, you will be back in your hotel to get ready for your evening in Monaco.** After a drive on the low corniche, passing Villefranche, Beaulieu, the Bay of Eze and Cap d'Ail, you will enjoy a tour in the old town of Monaco, passing the castle of the Prince and the cathedral. The drive through the Principality will give you a complete overview of the second smallest country in the world. You will then reach the district of Monte-Carlo for the rest of the evening.
- **It is the perfect place for a fine dinner, a casino experience or a drink at a club.** Depending on where your hotel is, on the way back enjoy a drive by the medium corniche, passing the village of Eze all lit up.

## Nice and St-Paul de Vence

- **Your driver will pick you up at the hotel after breakfast, with your luggage, as you will stay at luxury Golf resort Terre Blanche tonight.**
- This morning, you will explore the Old town of Nice, its secrets streets, hidden chapels, its cathedral and emblematic flower market. Nice has a strong southern identity, a real charm. Around noon, your food tour starts, with tastings of staple Niçoise food : pissaladière, olives, socca, ice-creams... (Italy is really close by!), if this whet your appetite, your guide will be happy to make recommendations for lunch, but if you don't have too much room for lunch anymore, we suggest enjoying a simple Salade Niçoise at a little café .
- In the afternoon, have a nice stroll in Saint-Paul de Vence before your chauffeur-guide drives you to the village of Vence nearby where you will explore the Chapelle du Rosaire that Matisse painted for the soeurs dominicaines and its beautiful yellow, green and blue glassworks. Arrive at Terre Blanche before dinner, your private refuge nestled among pine trees, vineyards, and olive trees. Check in your suite.
- **Dinner at one of the restaurants of the resort:** Faventia, a Michelin-starred restaurant serving creative, seasonal cuisine; Le Gaudina, an elegant brasserie with a bistro-style menu and a friendly atmosphere; Les Caroubiers, the clubhouse restaurant overlooking the golf course, offering a blackboard menu; and Le Tousco, a summery outdoor restaurant, ideal for a poolside meal.

### Golfing day: Terre Blanche

- Breakfast at hotel.
- **You're enjoying a game of golf at the resort today.** Nestled in a 301-hectare green setting, this peaceful haven invites you to enjoy an exceptional golfing experience. You can play in the shade of the pine trees or under the Mediterranean sun, accompanied by the sound of cicadas. The Terre Blanche Resort is home to two 18-hole championship courses designed by Dave Thomas.
- **You can golf with the pros of the Terre Blanche Golf Academy on request.**
- **Booking for lunch** at Golf's restaurant Les Caroubiers.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- **Overnight Terre Blanche.**

### Famous Rosés

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private chauffeur-guide collects you for a rosé-fuelled excursion day!
- The first estate you will visit today is **Chateau d'Esclans**, a provençal property near Saint-Tropez standing in a sea of vineyards. **Their Whispering Angel** is arguably one of the most famous names in the rosé world. You will enjoy a premium tour of the property, exploring the « chais », before being invited to a private tasting of all the estate's rosés, including Whispering Angel of course, but also world-famous Les Clans & Garrus.
- **Gourmet lunch** will be enjoyed at neighbour restaurant L'Hostellerie les Gorges de Pennafort, where chef Anthony Salliège creates a colourful menu inspired by local and seasonal products.
- **In the afternoon, you will be welcomed at Chateau Sainte-Roseline.** «only the winemaking facilities, but also the historic areas such as 11th-century Sainte Roseline's Chapel and adjacent 12th-century Cloister and learn all about their fascinating history. This is followed by a tasting of the Cru Classé wine in all 3 colours.
- Transfer back to hotel.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight Terre Blanche

### Golfing day: Vidauban

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to Vidauban Golf Club.
- **The Vidauban Golf Club** is nestled in a National Park, in the heart of the « Massif des Maures ». Parasol pines, cork trees and Mediterranean scrubland line the fairways of the course designed by legendary architect Robert Trent Jones Sr. The club established a foundation in 2007 to understand and preserve the biodiversity of the Plaine des Maures, and to educate the public thanks to a bespoke educational platform.



- Enjoy a Mediterranean light lunch at the Club House.
- **Transfer back to hotel.** Rest of the day at leisure, I recommend relaxing in the resort emblematic swimming pool, famous for its dramatic white columns, exquisite light and serene views on the property park.
- **Dinner with our recommendations.** Overnight Terre Blanche

## Saint-Tropez

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private chauffeur-guide collects you at hotel and drives you to iconic Saint-Tropez .
- In the morning you will enjoy a tour of the historic city center with a private guide to understand how this little fishermen village became one of the most chic and fashionable destinations of the French Riviera. Enjoy the cute pedestrian streets, the port and the old village.
- Private transfer to medieval hamlet of Grimaud for a short guided visit, followed by panoramic lunch at Le Bello Visto in Gassin, one of our favourite.
- After lunch, your chauffeur-guide drives you along “route des plages” (the beach route) through the vineyards, toward the wine estate you will visit today, Chateau des Mares in Ramatuelle. You will enjoy a private tour of the estate, followed by a 4 wines of the property.
- After this fantastic rosé experience, your chauffeur drives you back, passing by Sainte-Anne chapel , a charming chapel dedicated to the people working at sea (view from the outside as chapel is closed to public) with stunning view on the bay.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight Terre Blanche.

## Golf Day : Old Course Golf Cannes-Mandelieu

- Breakfast and check out. Private transfer to the Golf de Cannes Mandelieu
- **Founded in 1923, the Old course Cannes-Mandelieu** is in the middle of a Mediterranean forest, close to the sea, and a genuine jewel of the Riviera. Prestigious members included at the time Prince Pierre of Monaco, the Aga Kahn or the baron Edouard de Rothschild who were at the origin of the Golf. Its 18 holes course, originally designed by Harry Colt, who also created the iconic course of Saint-Cloud, has been recently revisited, offering a unique experience.
- **Enjoy a relaxed lunch** at the Golf’s restaurant Le 1923, overlooking the beautiful provençal landscape with the Alps mountains in the distance.
- **If you’re still feeling active after lunch**, we recommend some time in Cannes, not only the famous star-packed side of it, the red carpet stairs, the Croisette... But also the traditional side of the city, with its beautiful market and perched village-like Le Suquet area, unless you prefer taking a short boat ride to the Lérins islands,

- including off the beaten track island Saint-Honorat and its Monastery founded in the 5th century. Walk this tiny mediterranean paradise surrounded by the sea with your guide and enjoy a tasting of the wine produced by the monks!The boat ride back to Cannes offers an incredible panorama over the Alps.
- Return transfer at your hotel and evening and dinner at leisure with our recommendations.
- Overnight Terre Blanche.
