The Golf Experience



A Four-Act Golf Story. This experience is designed like a four-act story. Deauville sets the tone with heritage and style. Granville shifts you into pure elements—true links golf where the ground game matters. Omaha Beach adds the coastal reveal and a sense of emotion tied to the landscape. Champ de Bataille delivers the finale: refined woodland parkland on a château estate, calm, precise, and quietly impressive. The point isn't variety for variety's sake—it's a rhythm that keeps every day distinct.



- **Golf Barrière Deauville (Mont-Canisy)**

Perched above Deauville, this 1929 Normandy classic offers three distinct 9-hole loops designed by Tom Simpson and Henry Cotton—strategic, impeccably kept, and quietly demanding. It has real tournament pedigree: Open de France history and, more recently, the **Lacoste Ladies Open de France**.

- **Granville Links (Baie du Mont-Saint-Michel)**

France's purest links: dunes, wind, firm turf, and a course that changes daily. First laid out in 1912 and reworked by Harry Colt in 1921, it's the reference for authentic links golf—angles and creativity over raw power.

- **Omaha Beach Golf (Port-en-Bessin)**

A 36-hole venue set between D-Day coastline and rolling countryside, with two contrasting 18s: **La Mer and Le Manoir**. Signature moment: the coastal green above Port-en-Bessin harbour on La Mer—great for groups and full-day golf.

- **Golf du Champ de Bataille (Le Neubourg)**

A refined château-estate parkland course, atmospheric and impeccably "Normandy." Created in 1990 by Robin Nelson with landscaper Thierry Huau, it rewards discipline and precise angles; holes 12 and 13 were later redesigned by Manuel Rossi.

Golf days alternate with gastronomic and cultural moments—Michelin tables, Calvados cellars, coastal seafood and historic sites—creating a journey that feels hosted, coherent and never rushed.



- **In the footsteps of the Impressionists**

Guests will enter the luminous world of **Monet, Renoir, Pissarro, Boudin...** and travel through the most iconic landscapes of Normandy painted by these great artists. **In Giverny**, they will stroll through the secret gardens that inspired the Water Lilies, where the play of light on the flowers gives the impression of stepping into a living canvas. They will then follow the gentle curves of **the Seine to Honfleur**, where the cobbled streets and sparkling old port still echo with the brushstrokes of the masters. A bespoke immersion capturing the very soul of Impressionism.

- **The Private D-Day Legacy Experience**

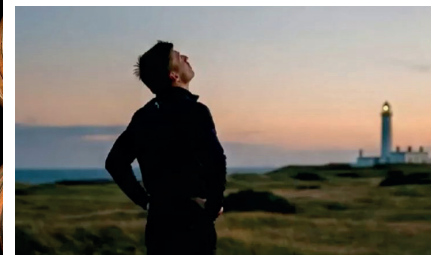
Guests uncover Normandy's D-Day legacy through **an exclusive, privately guided journey** across the iconic landing beaches.

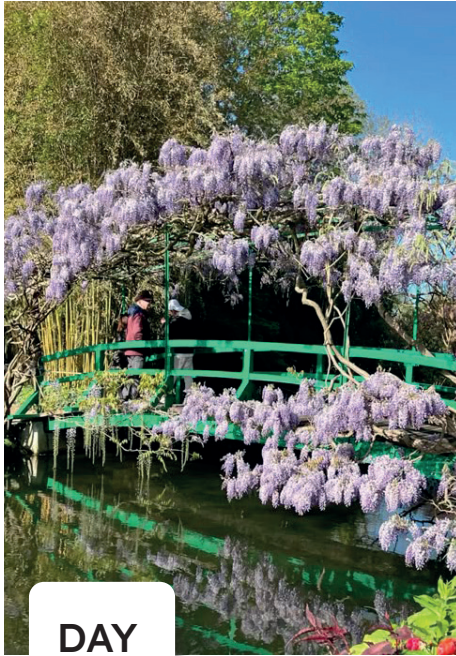

**DAY
1**

Welcome to France, en route to Giverny in Normandy!

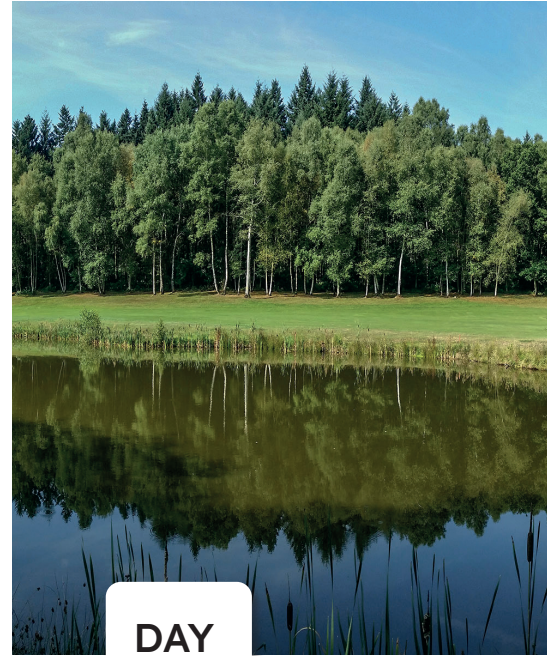
- Your private chauffeur collects you at Paris Roissy CDG Airport in a Mercedes car and drives you toward Normandy.
- Your first stop is the « impressionists village », the lovely **Giverny**.
- Check in boutique Hotel-Restaurant Le Jardin des Plumes, owned by Michelin chef David Gallienne. The rooms are contemporary and cosy.
- **Welcome dinner at La Table du Chef**, where **chef Galienne** welcomes you for an outstanding Michelin experience.
- Overnight at Le Jardin des Plumes in Giverny.



**DAY
2**

Giverny and Seine river

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Walk to late **French painter Claude Monet's** family home, studio and garden, where he painted his world-famous waterlilies. A local guide meets you there for a private tour of the property and gardens.
- Lunch will be enjoyed in a trendy riverside **bistro « Blossom »**.
- We can hire a chauffeur or organize some e-bikes for you.
- After lunch, walk to nearby « **Moulin de Vernon** », a former mill located on the right bank of the river Seine, emblematic of this area, that inspired many painters. The traditional half-timbered walls are beautiful.
- Back in Le Jardin des Plumes, your chef awaits you for a fun and hands-on cooking class, followed by a tasting of what you've prepared together.
- Overnight at Le Jardin des Plumes in Giverny.



**DAY
3**

Golfing day: Golf Champ de Bataille

- Breakfast at hotel and check out.
- Private transfer to Golf Champ de Bataille.
- This fairly new golf course is located in the woods surrounding a local Chateau. Its curves embrace the shapes of the valley and the course weaves through the ornamental ponds. Designed by American architect Robin Nelson and French landscaper Thierry Huau, the course enhances the natural beauty of the natural site. Huge rhododendrons and ferns cover the undergrowth. A pastoral haven of rest and quietness.
- Lunch will be enjoyed in the Golf's restaurant « Les Terrasses » overlooking the forest.
- Private transfer to your Normand hotel.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight Normandy.



**DAY
4**

Welcome in Côte Fleurie

- **Breakfast at hotel.**
- Today you will make your way to the «**Côte Fleurie**» area, for a relaxing day exploring what Normandy has the best to offer in term of scenery and atmosphere.
- In the morning, you will explore the super posh seaside town of Deauville and its twin sister town cheeky Trouville, with its seafood stalls and art deco casino. You will also enjoy a ride through the green inner country "**Pays d'Auge**" with Calvados farms and quaint villages. This is where I recommend lunch.
- In the afternoon, you will explore the charming **port of Honfleur**, home of composer Erik Satie and painter Eugene Boudin, its postcard-like fishing port, pedestrian city center, Sainte-Catherine church and the painters and poets chapel overlooking the Seine estuary.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight Normandy.



DAY
5

Golfing day: Golf Barrière de Deauville

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to Golf Barrière de Deauville.
- Opened in 1929 on the heights of Mont-Canisy, Golf Barrière Deauville is located a few minutes from Deauville town centre. Architects Tom Simpson and Henry Cotton designed the courses, thus giving every player a diversity of experiences in an environment of 70 hectares. Magnificently maintained and offering numerous views over the sea and countryside, the Golf Barrière Deauville is a genuine championship golf course that has welcomed many competitions and events.
- Lunch will be enjoyed at the cosy and British-inspired Club house. The carte offers classic favorites such as Caesar salad, grilled entrecôte or Club sandwich.
- In the afternoon, transfer back to your hotel.
- Afternoon at leisure.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight Normandy.



DAY
6

D-Day Beaches

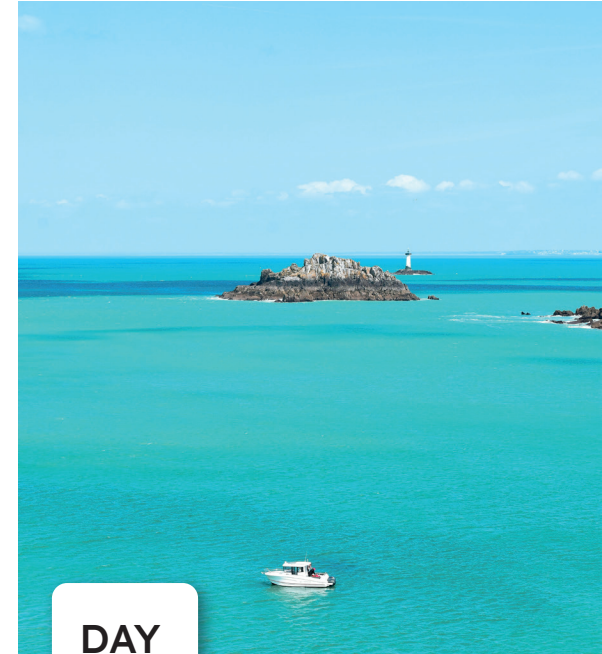
- Breakfast at hotel.
- We will appoint a chauffeur and a private guide for you everyday. Your guide is a specialist of **D-Day** history.
- Today will be dedicated to the D-Day sites on the western side of the coast, toward Cherbourg, with a focus on Utah beach, Pointe du Hoc, Omaha beach, Sainte-Mère l'église and the American cemetery. Your guide will adapt the pace of the tour to your preferences. He will add stops according to your interest.
- Lunch will be enjoyed with his recommendations.
- If you leave in the morning around 9 am, you will enjoy Utah in the morning, then lunch, then Pointe du Hoc, Omaha beach and American cemetery in the afternoon and you can be back at the hotel around 5 pm. Those are approximate times.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight Normandy.



DAY
7

Golfing day: Golf Omaha beach

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to **Golf Omaha beach**.
- The Omaha Beach golf course is located by the sea, just outside Bayeux, a few kilometers from the D-Day landing beaches and the American cemetery at Colleville-sur-mer, where Steven Spielberg shot several scenes in the film "Saving Private Ryan". Its 36 holes offer 2 different courses: La Mer, which takes you all the way to hole 6, whose green overlooks the port of Port-en-Bessin, and Le Manoir, with its nine new holes around an exceptional stretch of water, offering a real golfing challenge with breathtaking views over the Bessin countryside.
- Lunch at restaurant **l'Albatros**, on the golf.
- Afternoon at leisure and dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight Normandy.



DAY
8

Mont Saint-Michel and Cancale

- Breakfast at hotel and check out.
- In the morning, private chauffeur-guide collects you and drives you to **the Mont St Michel**. Explore the hamlet and abbey together.
- This afternoon, you will explore the Brittany side of the bay, including the cute seaside town of Cancale, famous for its **oyster's market**, and walled city of **Saint-Malo**, with its historic pedestrian center.
- Enjoy the strong Celtic influence of this area. I recommend an oyster tasting or seafood platter or lunch!
- Private transfer to Relais & Châteaux Chateau Richeux, overlooking the Mont Saint-Michel bay. Check in your suite.
- I recommend dinner at **Rollinger's Bistrot de Cancale**, unless you want to try the famous galettes!
- Overnight Chateau Richeux.



DAY
9

Golfing day Golf de Granville

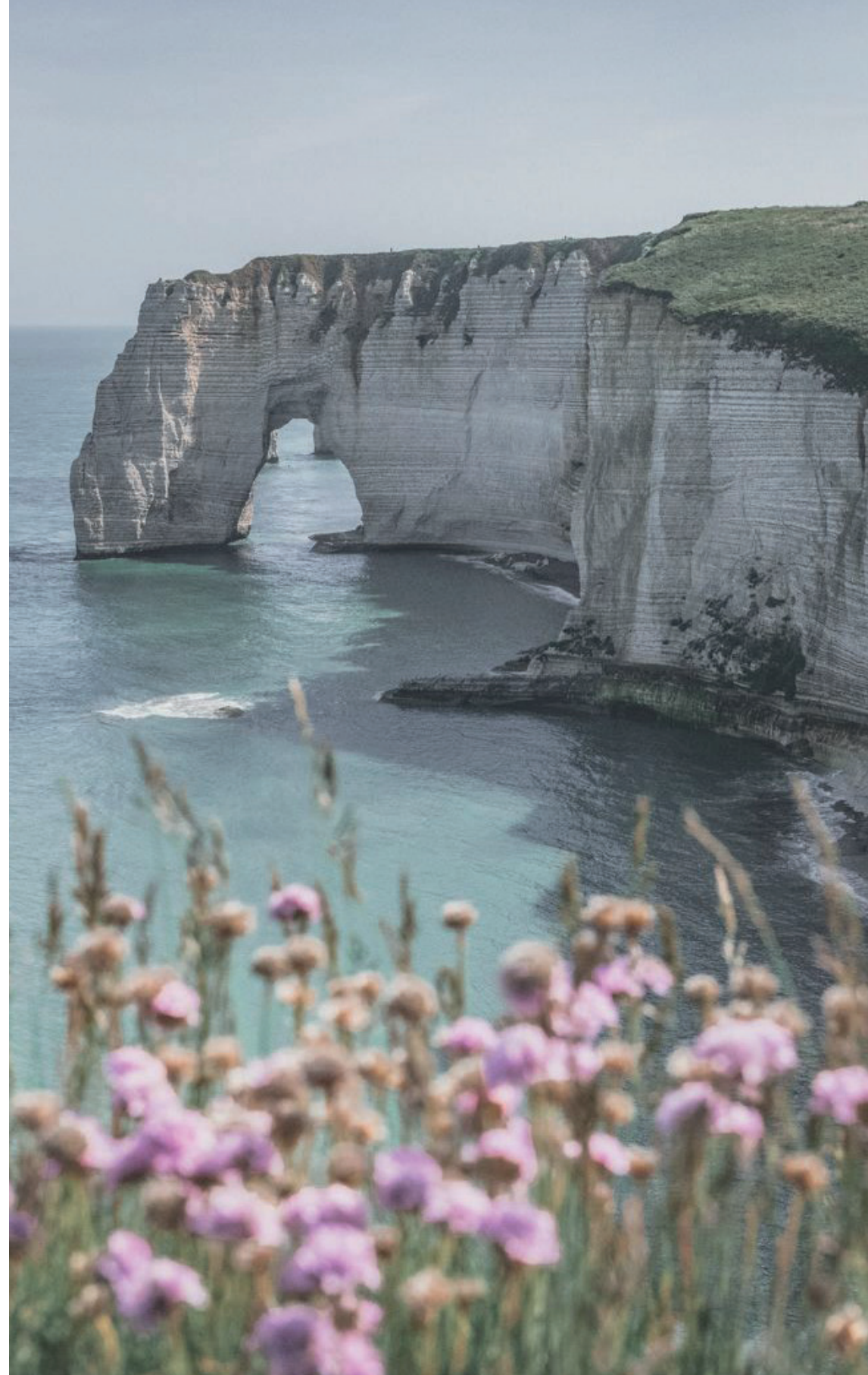
- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to Golf de Granville.
- The **Golf Club de Granville**, located in Normandy in the Manche department, is a renowned establishment created in 1912. Designed by architect Harry Shapland Colt, it offers two links courses unique in France: an 18-hole course and a 9-hole course. These courses, often compared to the historic courses of Ireland and Scotland, are renowned for their authenticity and demanding nature. The golf course offers an exceptional natural setting shaped by sea dunes.
- Lunch at the Golf's fish restaurant.
- Afternoon at leisure.
- Michelin dinner at Chef Hugo Rollinger 3 Michelin stars restaurant Le Coquillage.
- Overnight Chateau Richeux.
