Paris is the ultimate expression of culture, haute couture, luxury, gastronomy, and the art of living. An intoxicating blend of elegance and inspiration, this tailor-made stay invites guests to immerse themselves in the very essence of the City of Light. Guest can crown their trip with a private and luxurious getaway in the legendary Champagne region.



The Golf Experience



- **Golf de Chantilly** (Vineuil-Saint-Firmin)

One of the true aristocrats of French golf, set in the Chantilly forest just north of Paris. The club was founded by Baron Edouard de Rothschild, and the Tom Simpson course most golfers come for—Vineuil—opened in 1920. It's classic, understated, and beautifully strategic: the kind of course that rewards restraint and shot-shaping over brute force. Chantilly has hosted the French Open ten times and remains a reference point for traditional French club golf.

- **Golf de Saint-Nom-la-Bretèche** (West of Paris)

A proper French country club with serious pedigree, created through the vision of Daniel Féau and designed by Fred Hawtree. The first course opened in 1959, followed by the second in 1960, giving the club two excellent 18-hole tests (Red and Blue). It's polished, tree-lined parkland golf where positioning matters and the atmosphere feels quietly exclusive. A historic tournament venue too, notably linked to the Trophée Lancôme and the Open de France.

- **Le Golf National** (Albatros, Guyancourt)

France's flagship stadium course: bold, modern, and built to host the biggest stages. The Albatros opened on 5 October 1990 and was co-designed by Hubert Chesneau and Robert von Hagge. It's the long-time home of the Open de France and famously hosted the 2018 Ryder Cup, then Olympic golf in 2024. The closing stretch—water, grandstands, and pressure—is as "major-championship" as it gets in continental Europe.

Paris isn't a resort golf destination—it's heritage and pedigree. In a short radius, you get three distinct faces of French golf: Chantilly, aristocratic and understated in the forest; Saint-Nom-la-Bretèche, polished country-club parkland with quiet exclusivity; and Le Golf National (Albatros), France's stadium test built for pressure and big stages. Together, it's a simple trilogy: tradition, club culture, championship intensity.

Indulging in one of the capital's Michelin-starred restaurants, gazing over the City of Light from the Eiffel Tower, **getting lost in Montmartre's bohemian charm**, then drifting along the Seine at sunset with a glass of champagne... **Paris doesn't simply welcome—it seduces.** A short escape to Champagne extends that feeling. Guests step behind the doors of the great houses, descend into chalk cellars where time seems to slow, and taste vintages that reveal the region's quiet magic. In Champagne, elegance sparkles, temptation lingers—and guests return to Paris completely charmed.



- **Versailles, Unveiled in Private**

Guests are immersed in the majestic beauty of the Chateau de Versailles and discover its treasures **outside of public opening hours.** They explore **the Hall of Mirrors, the private royal apartments, and the vast gardens**, guided by an enthusiastic guide who brings history to life. The hushed elegance and serene atmosphere allow guests to appreciate every detail, from art to architecture, in complete privacy.

- **An Intimate Evening at Veuve Clicquot**

Guests are immersed in the timeless elegance of the Veuve Clicquot mansion during an intimate private dinner. **They savor a tailor-made menu**, perfectly paired with the house's finest champagnes, each sip celebrating the art of fine dining. **An evening of pure sophistication**, where gastronomy, heritage and the spirit of Veuve Clicquot come together in perfect harmony.

- **A Seductive Bakery Journey**

Accompanied by a passionate guide, guests slip into the best artisan bakeries in Montmartre. They savor daring creations, learn the secrets of spotting a truly exceptional bakery, and never settling for an ordinary croissant again. 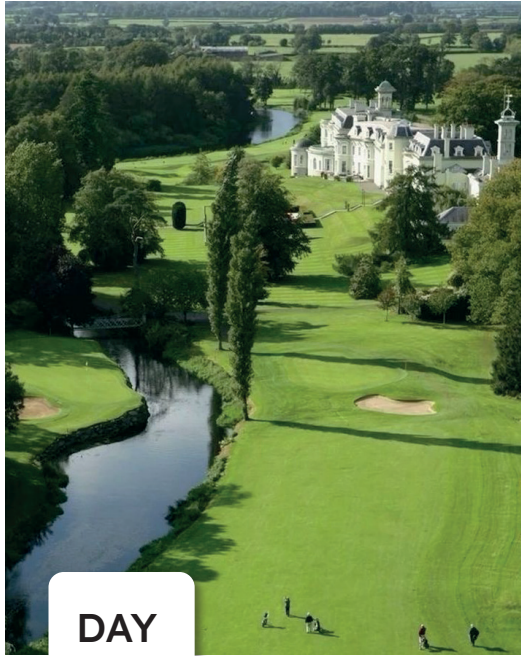

Welcome to France, en route to Chantilly!

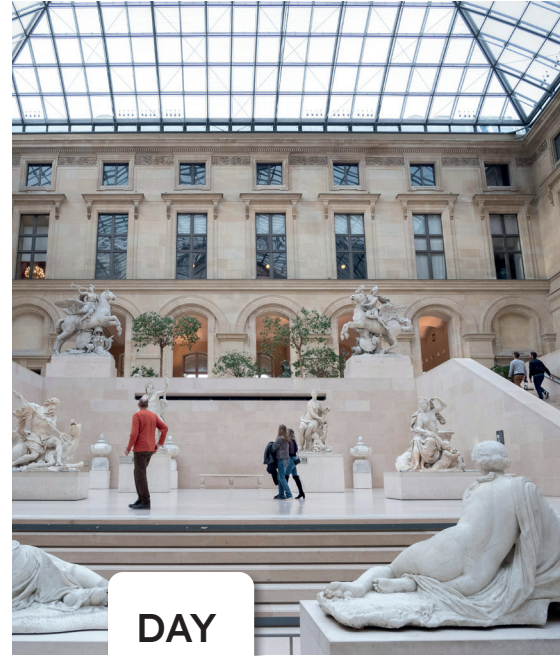
- Your private chauffeur will collect you at Paris Roissy CDG Airport in a Mercedes car and drive you to your hotel in Chantilly.

Golfing day: Chantilly Golf

- Breakfast at hotel.
- This golf course is located in an exceptional setting in the Chantilly forest. The quality of the design, the perfect maintenance of the course, and the rich history of this club have rightly earned it an international reputation. The Chantilly Golf Club was inaugurated in 1909. It was designed by British architect Tom Simpson and redesigned by Donald Steel to offer two 18-hole championship courses.
- Lunch will be enjoyed in the Golf's restaurant.

3

Paris Discovery & private tour at “Le Louvre Museum”

- Breakfast at hotel and check out.
- Your driver will pick you up at the hotel and take you to Paris.
- Meet your **private lecturer-guide who embarks you on a 3h city tour with your chauffeur** : This is dedicated to **the discovery of Paris most famous sites and landmarks**. Your chauffeur is at disposal to drive you around and makes stops so your guide can comment the different places. All the classic sites will appear in front of your eyes : the Eiffel Tower, les Invalides area, where you can drive past the golden Coppola and the Army museum, the Arc de Triomphe, The Champs Elysées Avenue and the Place de la Concorde with its famous Egyptian « obélisque ». Along the way, you'll learn intriguing anecdotes about Paris's past, present, and future.
- Booking for lunch with our recommendations.
- In the afternoon, you will enjoy a **private guided tour of the Louvre Museum**. If you love art, a visit to the Louvre Museum is a must. Home to hundreds of thousands of classical and modern masterpieces, the Louvre is a testament to the history of European art. You can choose to follow the trail of the most famous works of art with Mona Lisa as the highlight of the tour but it's a very busy one. Golfing day: Saint-Nom-la-Bretèche Golf

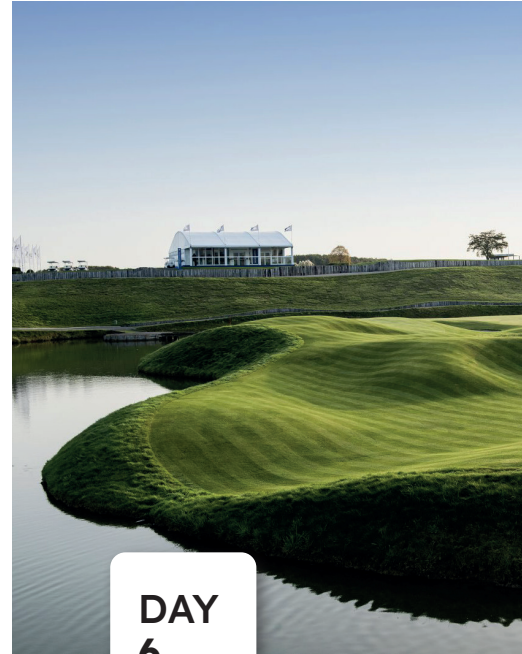
- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to **Saint-Nom-la-Bretèche Golf**. Opened in 1959, the Saint-Nom-la-Bretèche Golf Club is a private golf club with two 18-hole courses. The clubhouse is housed in a magnificent 18th-century farmhouse, which was once a royal outbuilding of the Palace of Versailles. Architect Fred Hawtree designed the two courses at Saint-Nom in the tradition of the great Anglo-Saxon golf courses. **The Saint-Nom-la-Bretèche Golf Club is reserved for its members and their guests.** It is therefore a unique experience!
- Reservation for lunch at the clubhouse.
- Rest of the day at leisure.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight in Paris.



DAY
5

Full day in Versailles

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Private transfer to Château de Versailles.
- Full day in Versailles, including the castle, garden, lunch at Ducasse's restaurant Ore and Trianon. **Visiting Versailles is entering French history.** In every corner of the palace, in every reflection of the hall of mirrors, in every alley of the garden, you will feel and understand how intrigues of the court, political decisions and everyday life of the monarchy unfolded within the walls of this outstanding royal estate. The site includes the Palace, the garden, the Grand Trianon and Marie-Antoinette's estate.
- You will enjoy the lunch at **Ducasse's restaurant Ore**, located inside the Château.

- The Golf National was inaugurated in 1990. The architects, Hubert Chesneau and Robert Von Hagge, designed two 18-hole courses. It is the home course of the French Golf Federation. This golf has already hosted the Ryder Cup and the golf events for the 2024 Paris Olympics were held on the Albatros course.
- Reservation for lunch at the clubhouse.
- Private transfer back to hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.
- Dinner with our recommendations.
- Overnight in Paris.



DAY
7

Food tour & Michelin dinner

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Meet your private guide for a **Food Tour in Montmartre**, one of the most famous districts in Paris. This 3-hour walking tour will be the occasion to discover the cobbled streets of Montmartre village, its grape vine and mills, as well as its best restaurants and shops. You will visit some of the best bread and pastry shops in town. You will learn why the best baguettes are in Montmartre and how to find the best croissant! For lunch, if you are still hungry, your guide will recommend a restaurant.
- After lunch or the gastronomic tour, we'll book you a **private cruise on the Seine** in a vintage wooden boat. For 1 hour and 20 minutes, rediscover Paris from unusual angles and admire a city listed as a World Heritage Site. Enjoy the tranquility of the river, the sensations offered by the proximity to the water. A bottle of champagne and sweet accompaniments will be served to make this moment even more enchanting. recommend a restaurant.

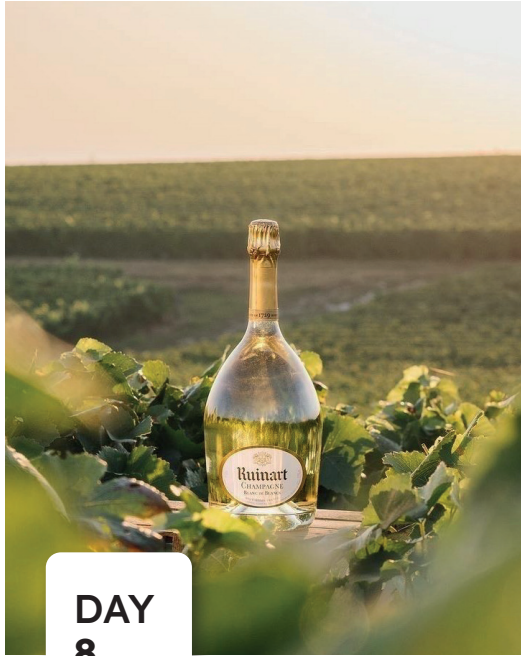

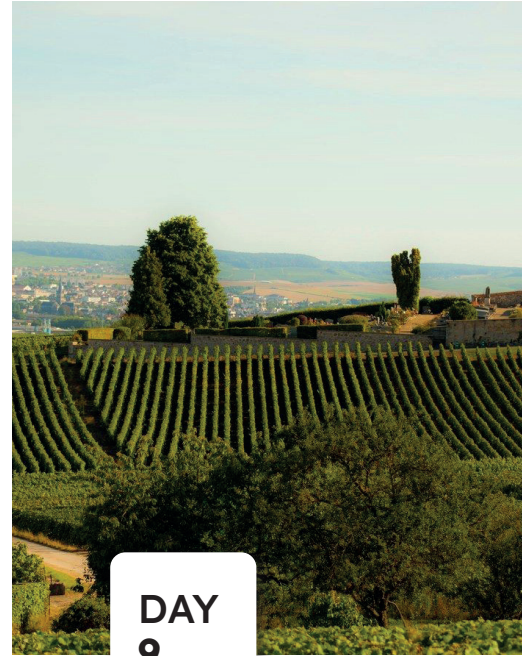
